

## Instructions for linking a Chalk & Wire Assignment to your Canvas Course – Multiple Programs

To create a Chalk and Wire assignment:

1. After opening the **+Assignment** form, name the assignment for your Chalk and Wire key assessment.
2. Go ahead and enter your Points, Assignment Group, and Grade Display options
3. For the Submission Type select **External Tool** and click **Find**.

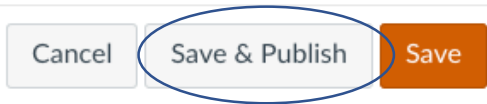

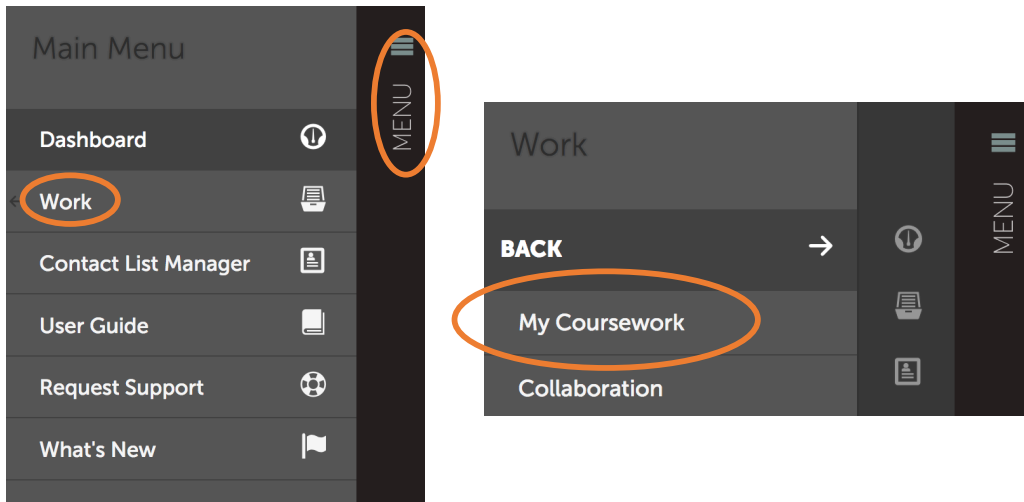
5. Choose your Assign to and Date options.
6. Click **Save and Publish**.



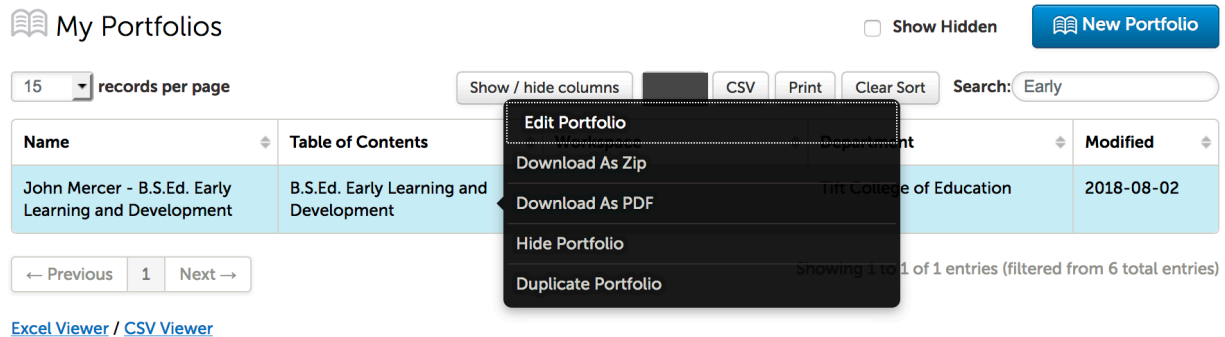
7. The Chalk & Wire Dashboard page will show up within your Canvas screen. When your students click on the assignment, they will also see the Dashboard page. Students will follow the accompanying instructions to submit their assignments directly into their Chalk & Wire portfolios.
8. Important Note: Because there is no linked assignment, the grade from Chalk & Wire will not automatically integrate into the Canvas gradebook.

# Instructions for Submitting a Chalk & Wire Assignment from Your Portfolio

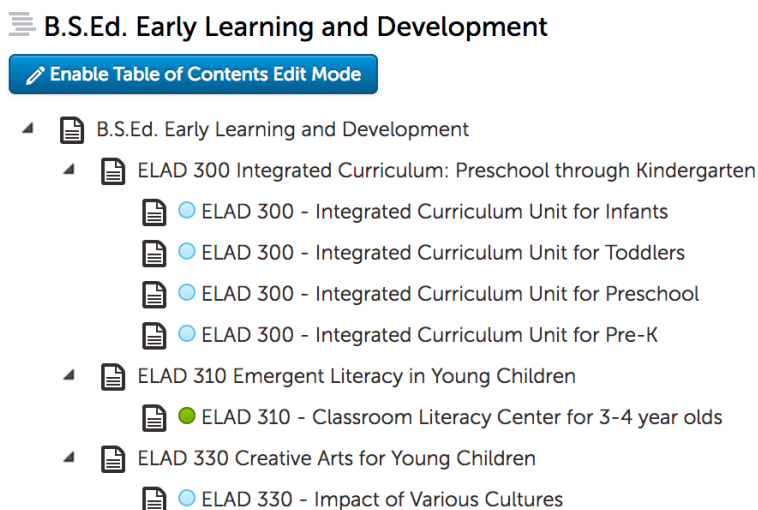
1. Click on **MENU**, **Work**, and **My Coursework**.



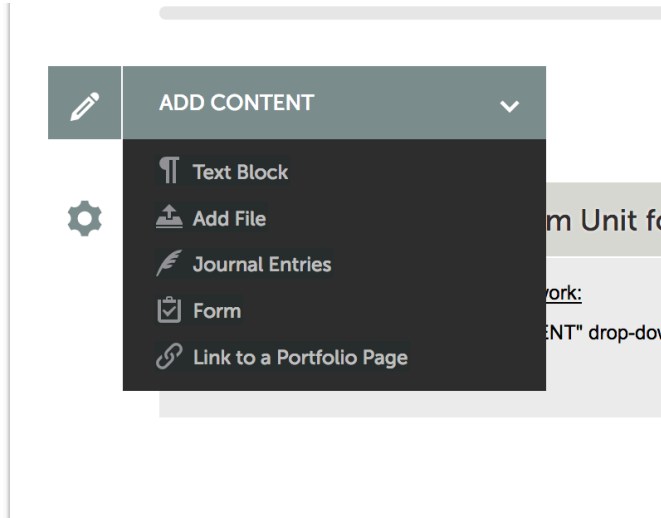
2. Click on your portfolio and click **Edit Portfolio**.



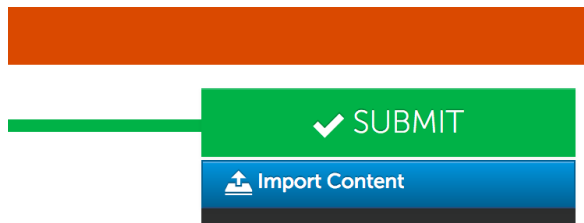
3. Click on the assignment you wish to submit under the correct course.

5. Once you have added your content, click **SUBMIT** in the upper right hand corner.
