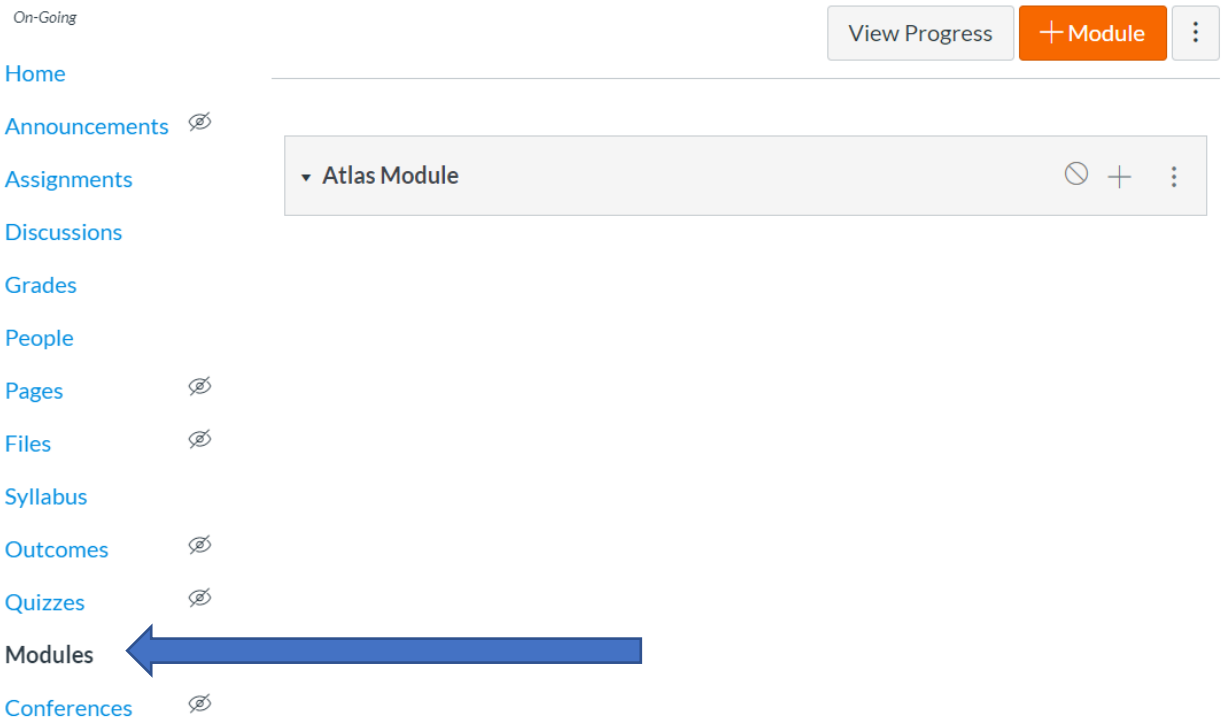
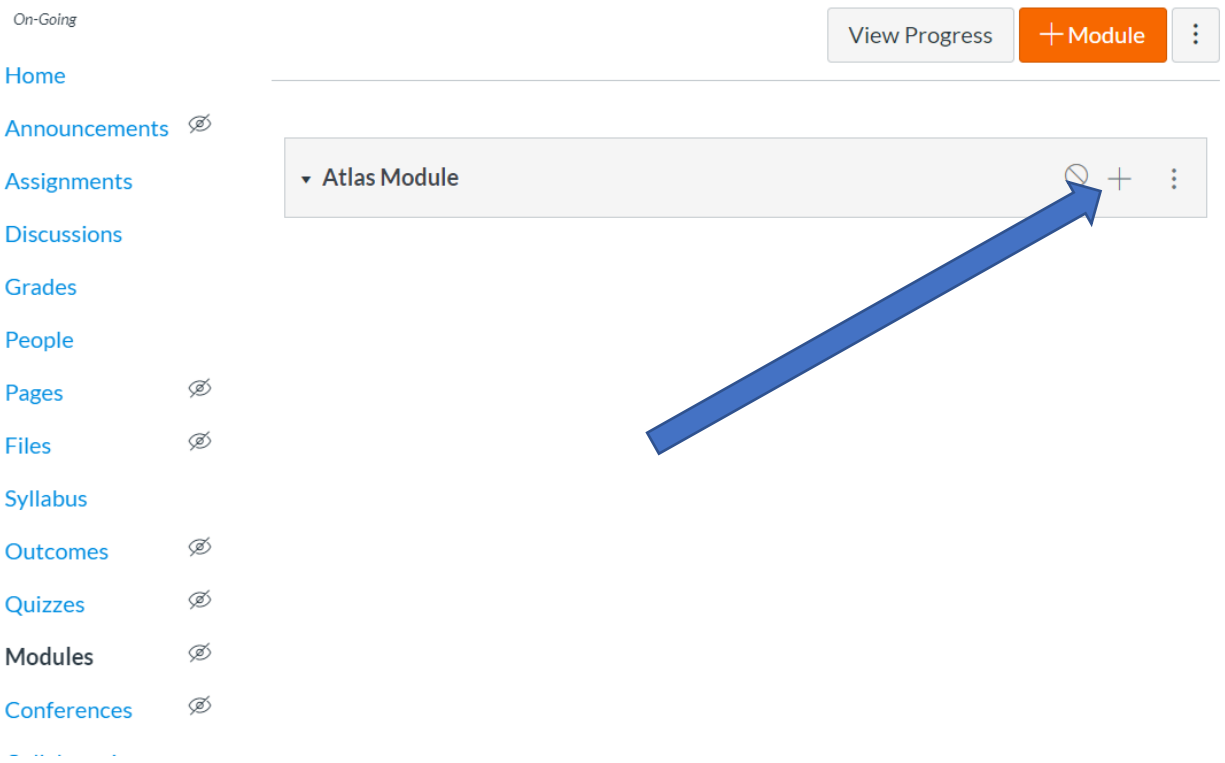


Linking to Atlas from Canvas

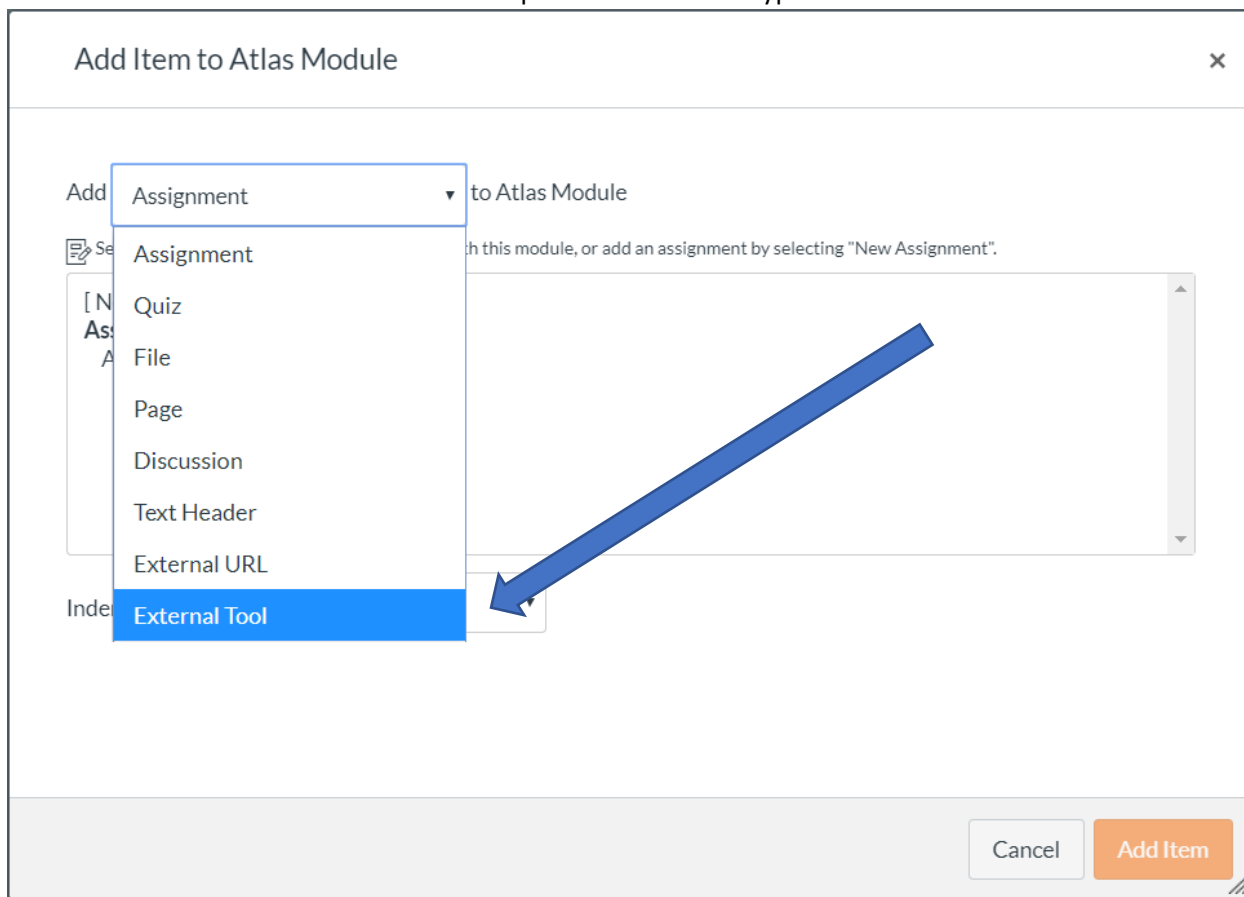
1. Navigate to the Modules section of your Canvas Course



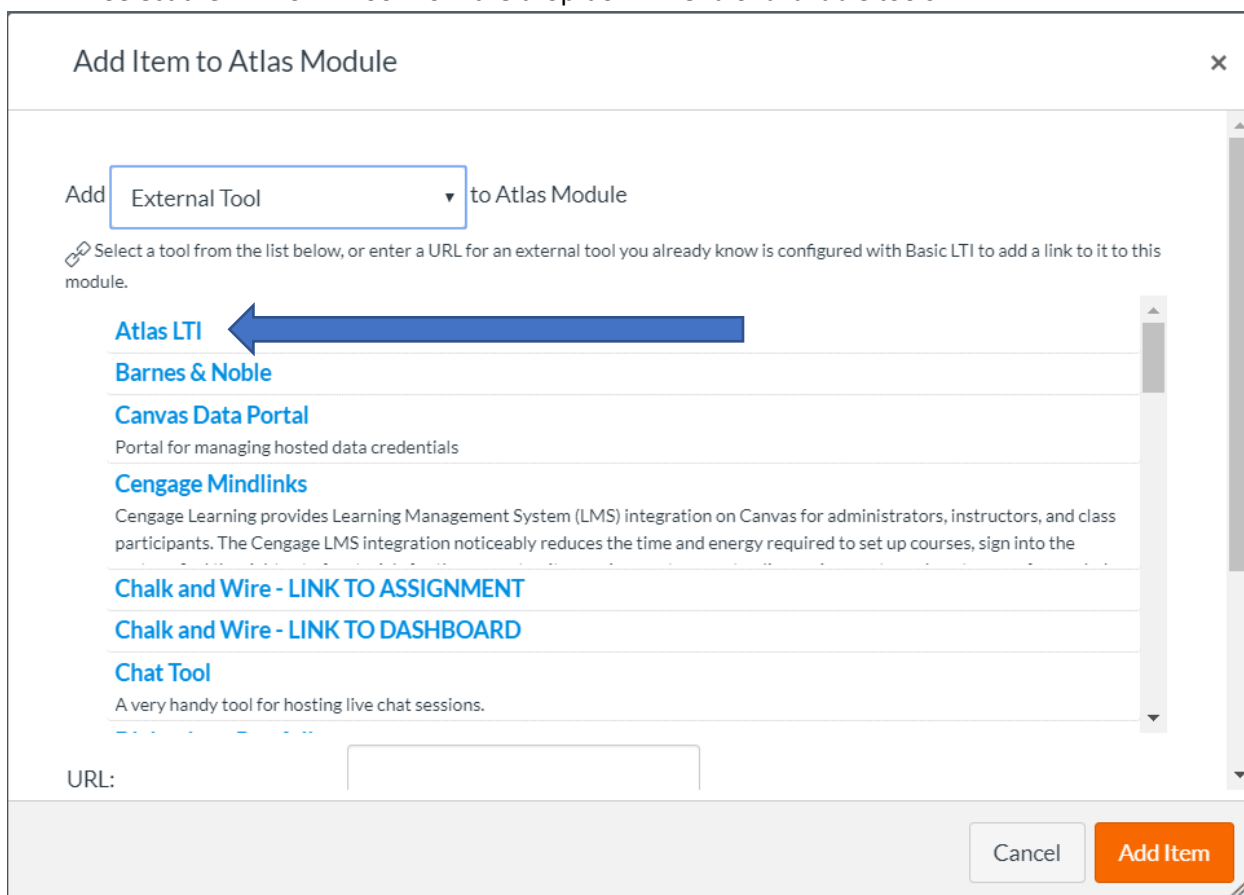
2. Click the grey + button next to the Module Heading to add a new item to the Module



3. Select "External Tool" from the drop-down list of item types
