

GACE Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment (Test Code 360)

Registration Information

You are required to take and pass the Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment (test code 360) for admission to our teacher education program.

See instructions below:

< Use Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge to register and take your Georgia Educator Ethics – Program Exit (code 360) test.>

1. Go to www.gapsc.com and login to your MyPSC account. You will need to enter your email address and password. Then click on the **Login** tab.
2. Go to the **MyPSC Dashboard** on the left hand side of the screen.
3. Click on the **Assessments tab** and then **choose #7.**
4. Under the Request Eligibility to Take a GACE Assessment Option, choose **Select an Assessment.**
5. Choose the dropdown arrow and choose **Select Georgia Educator Ethics (360) test.**
6. Click on the **Add Button.**
7. After you setup up this information on your MyPSC account, it will automatically be sent to the testing center. **Do not click on the “Click to Register” option. Please check your email for the link to register and pay for your Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment (test code 360) test.** It will take 1 to 2 days for a link to be sent to your email address. This test will cost \$30.00 and you can take it on your home computer. It will take about 2 to 4 hours to complete this test.
8. After you watch each module, there will be questions for you to answer. You can save your test if you need to complete it at a later time.
9. After you finish taking your Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment, please scan and email me your completion certificate. My email address is sherman_cs@mercer.edu.
10. Your test results will automatically be sent to the Georgia Professional Standards Commission database in 3 to 5 days.
