ADVANCED TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM



Mercer University's **Master of Education (M.Ed.) – The Advanced Teacher** degree is a fully online 30-hour program that prepares teachers to provide better support for their students. This program is designed to instruct and cultivate teachers to have an expanded philosophy of growth and change based on reliable knowledge and reflections on the best practices of teaching and learning.

Through the program, teachers gain the ability to understand and apply the skills of data analysis and educational research to impact educational experiences for all students. Mercer's M.Ed. – The Advanced Teacher degree is designed for teachers with a Level 4 certificate. Concentrations are available in:

- **Elementary Education**
- **Middle Grades Education**
- **Secondary Education**
- **P-12 Education**

Successful completion of the program will lead to eligibility for an upgrade of the candidate's teaching certification to a Level 5 certificate by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC).

Admission Requirements

Applicants seeking admission must hold a bachelor's degree from a college or university accredited by an institutional accreditor recognized by the U.S. Department of Education with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 and be certified teachers who hold a valid Level 4 or higher teaching certificate in the appropriate teaching field.*

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS INCLUDE:

- Completed application for admission
- \$25 non-refundable application fee
- Official transcripts from all previously attended institutions
- Current copy of teaching certificate

*Appropriate teaching fields vary by program:

- *Elementary Education program applicants:*
Elementary Education, Elementary Education/ Special Education General Curriculum, or Birth-Kindergarten
- *Middle Grades Education program applicants:*
One or more Middle Grades (4-8) content areas
- *Secondary Education program applicants:*
One or more Secondary (6-12) content areas
