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Master of Education (M.Ed.) in Educational Leadership - Tier I

Mercer's **M.Ed. in Educational Leadership with Tier I certification** is designed to prepare candidates with one or more years of teaching or related experience for leadership positions up to the assistant principal within the school, or a variety of district-level leadership positions that do not supervise principals or other district leaders. The program includes relevant and rigorous clinical practice, which provides opportunities for candidates to apply knowledge and skills learned in the program to become effective school leaders with an emphasis on instructional leadership.

Upon completion of the program and passing scores on the Georgia Assessments for the Certification of Educators (GACE) Educational Leadership content assessment, candidates will be eligible for Level 5 Educational Leadership certification.

This program is also offered as a non-degree program to eligible applicants who already hold Level 5 certification.

Built-In Mentorship Opportunity

Current M.Ed. in Educational Leadership - Tier I candidates have the opportunity to provide mentorship to individuals pursuing their Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T.) through Mercer University's **Georgia Educators Networking to Revolutionize and Transform Education (GENERATE)** teacher residency program. The GENERATE program provides a path for career changers to obtain their M.A.T., become certified teachers in the State of Georgia, and teach in high-need content areas within partner school districts.

Specialist in Education (Ed.S.) in Educational Leadership - Tier II

Mercer's **Ed.S.** in **Educational Leadership with Tier II certification** supports current educational leaders in the development of leadership theory and practical skills as they look to advance to the top levels of educational leadership. Diverse field experiences throughout the program help prepare leaders to support the needs of their educators, staff, students, and community. Mercer's faculty provide continual support to candidates, assisting in their development as transformational leaders.

Upon completion of the program and passing the Professional Assessment for School Leaders (PASL), candidates will be eligible to upgrade their leadership certificate to Level 6. Leaders with this certification are eligible for all leadership positions at the building and district levels.

Eligible Ph.D. candidates on the P-12 School Leadership track may choose an option to earn their Tier II certification while enrolled in the Ph.D. program.

This program is also offered as a non-degree program to eligible applicants who already hold Level 6 certification.
