

# M.S. in Instructional Design and Technology



Mercer University's **Master of Science in Instructional Design and Technology** equips students to use instructional design approaches in a variety of workplace, educational, and training contexts.

The degree provides a comprehensive curriculum focused on core instructional design principles that can be applied across disciplines. Whether students are working in a human resources office or a classroom, serving in a hospital or a military facility, the tools of instructional design impact their industry. The master's degree provides the flexibility to leverage existing expertise while integrating and applying new technologies and research-driven practices.

By completing the degree online, students will benefit from the modeling of instructional design practices in a flexible, asynchronous online format taught by experienced practitioners in the discipline.

Upon completion of the program, students will have the skills and knowledge to pursue jobs such as instructional coordinator, instructional designer, educational technologist, and training and development specialist.

This degree does not lead to a T-5 upgrade with the GaPSC.
