ADVANCED TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM



Mercer University's **Specialist in Education (Ed.S.) – The Accomplished Teacher** degree is a fully online 30-hour program that focuses on enhancing educators' knowledge and skills. This specialist degree prepares teachers to advance in their careers in education, and equips them with the necessary skills and experience for success.

Through this program, individuals gain a greater depth of knowledge relating to issues of diversity, curriculum assessment and development, theory and research, and pedagogy. Students also develop written and oral communication skills, which prepare them to advocate more effectively for their students, their students' families, and the community.

Mercer University's Ed.S. – The Accomplished Teacher is designed for teachers who are certified at the master's (T-5) level. Concentrations are available in:

- **Early Learning and Development (Birth Through Five Years)**
- **Elementary Education**
- **Middle Grades Education**
- **Secondary Education**
- **P-12 Education**

As part of the program curriculum, students complete courses necessary to earn a **Coaching endorsement**.

Successful completion of the program will lead to eligibility for an upgrade of the candidate's teaching certification to a Level 6 certificate by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC).

Admission Requirements

Applicants seeking admission must hold a master's degree from a college or university accredited by an institutional accreditor recognized by the U.S. Department of Education with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on all graduate work attempted. Applicants must possess or be eligible for a master's-level certificate, and provide documentation of one year of relevant experience as a certified educator.
